- Registered nurses who have graduated within the past five years from a state-approved Associate of Applied Science in Nursing or Diploma Nursing program or who have maintained continuous practice since graduation from such program will receive 30 semester hours of "advanced placement credit" after successfully completing (C+ or better) the first nine credits of nursing courses in the WIU RN-BSN Completion Program.
- After acceptance into the Nursing program, each student must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale for the coursework in the Nursing major to remain in the Nursing program.
