## **Transfer Facts**

- AA/AS Degree Satisfies Lower Division General Education Requirements: Yes
- Application Deadlines for Transfer Students: Apply as early as one year in advance and no later than one week prior to the start of the term.
- **Application Fee:** There is a onetime application fee of \$25.00. The application fee is waived for students who apply online.
- Course Transfer: 1) If a student has earned an AAS and is pursuing the BAMS
  (Bachelor of Applied Management Studies), 60 semester hours of transfer credit will
  be awarded at SAU. 2) If a student is pursuing a BA or BS degree, a maximum of
  16 semester hours of credit will be awarded for technical electives. 3) If a BHC
  certificate is earned, a maximum of 8 semester hours of credit will be awarded for
  technical electives.
- Dual Admission: BHC students may apply for dual admission with SAU. Interested students should send a completed dual admission agreement along with copies of their high school transcripts and all college transcripts to the SAU Office of Admissions. Dual admission students will have access to transfer planning, early transfer admission orientation programs, advising for seamless transfer, and other SAU resources. Students admitted to the dual admission program prior to completing 30 credit hours will receive a scholarship of \$1,000 beyond other SAU academic and institutional scholarships.
- Financial Aid: March 15<sup>th</sup> is the priority filing date for financial aid.
- Foreign Language: Transfer students for Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Science degrees must complete either three years of one foreign language in high school or two semesters of one foreign language at the college level (equivalent to 101 and 102 at BHC).
- **Grades of "D":** Grades of "D" will transfer if the student's cumulative GPA is 2.0 or above. All major courses and education courses must have a grade of "C" or better. A grade of C or better is required English composition, speech and math courses. Specific majors may have higher GPA requirements.
- Maximum Community College Hours Accepted in Transfer: 64
- Minimum Credit Hours to Apply Without High School Transcript and ACT: 12 semester hours
- Transfer Scholarships: Guaranteed minimum scholarships for transfer students
  are awarded based on Grade Point Average. Awards are renewable each year up
  to a maximum of 120 credits, including transfer hours. Scholarships are awarded for
  spring and fall semesters only.
