



The 2023 Stampede Auction of Champion Pumpkins set a new fundraising record at the Black Hawk College East Campus.

The Oct. 25 event raised money for <u>Kewanee Area United Way</u> (KAUW), where 100% of donated money stays in the community to assist as many as 16 area agencies in providing services to residents in need.

Auctioneer and East Campus alumnus Bill LeSage persuaded the audience of BHC students, employees, retirees and alumni to spend a new record grand total of \$8,400. The 2022 auction brought in \$8,325.


