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Classes at Black Hawk College for Transfer to St. Ambrose University Courses of Study for the Associate in Arts and Bachelor of Social Work Major

The 2+2 is a four-year plan that leads to an Associate in Arts (A.A.) degree at Black Hawk College and a Bachelor of Social Work (B.S.W.) degree at St. Ambrose University. This plan is designed to ensure graduation in four years by taking courses at both BHC and SAU. This plan assumes students have met all course prerequisites required by BHC and admission requirements for SAU.

Upon completion of the first two years' requirements at BHC, students will receive an A.A. degree. Upon completion of the final two years' curriculum requirements students will receive the B.S.W. degree at SAU. The minimum required for the A.A. is 64 credits. The minimum required for the B.S.W. is 120 credits.

A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00 is required to graduate from BHC and a 2.0 or better maintained to be eligible for graduation from SAU.
