Transfer Planning Guide

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TRANSFER FACTS

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- Students transferring to Augustana in Pre-Medicine and use this guide in conjunction with the Black Hawk College Associate in Arts (AA), may transfer to Augustana and complete their BA in Pre-Medicine in an additional two years.
- Students who earn the AA at Black Hawk College will meet the Learning Perspective requirement at Augustana.
- In addition to Learning Perspective requirements, students must meet the Writing, Second Language, Reasoned Examination of Faith (REF), Physical Education activities, Transfer Transitions course (LSC 300), as well as the Suffix requirements; Quantitative (Q), Global Diversity (G), Multicultural Diversity (D).
- Learning Perspectives, Second Language, Physical Education and Suffix requirements can be included in the Associate in Arts degree to be able to complete the BA at Augustana in an additional two years.
- Students must earn a minimum of 60 semester hours at Augustana to graduate.

1. All Augustana students must complete a course in both the Global Diversity (G) and Multicultural Diversity (D) suffixes. **One course may meet multiple requirements, so** BHC students may use the table below to see BHC courses that satisfy these various requirements.

- 2. If needed to reach 64 credits, students may select two one-hour Physical Education Activity courses from the PE category at BHC, however, this Augustana graduation requirement may also be completed at Augustana.
- 3. Generally taking Organic Chemistry following General Chemistry is recommended, but students also have an option to complete the PHYS 101 + PHYS 102 or PHYS 201 + PHYS 202 sequence at BHC. Choosing Organic Chemistry at BHC is a better option for students interested in applying to medical school directly after completion of the their degree at Augustana. Completing the Organic Chemistry sequence in year 2 allows for Augustana's CHEM 441, Biochemistry, to be taken in year 3 in preparation for the MCAT exam.
- 4. Augustana College has a second language requirement for graduation that students may meet in one of the following ways: Completion of four years of a single second language in high school. Satisfactory performance on a competency test at Augustana. Completion of course 102 in a foreign language at Augustana. The equivalent of one year of a foreign language at another college (101 & 102 at Black Hawk College).
- 5. Statistics (Math 108 or 228) is a recommended support course for Pre-medicine majors and meets the Augustana College Quantitative Reasoning (Q) requirement. To be eligible for Physics at Augustana, students should be calculus-ready (completed pre-calculus or have an Math Index score of 920+).
- 6. Augustana graduation requirement to be taken at Augustana.
- 7. Refer to Augustana website at www.augustana.edu for additional possible major/minors.
