# Things to do

### Step 1: Apply

### **Apply for Admission**

- Pay \$20 application fee.
- Look for your welcome letter in 1-2 business days at the email address you provided on the application.
- Send official transcripts from your high school and/or previous college.
- Send placement scores from another school or ACT/SAT test scores (taken within the last two years).
- Apply for financial aid at <u>fafsa.gov</u>. BHC's school code is 001638. FAFSA is available
  December 2023 for the following fall semester. Get more information about <u>Financial</u>
  Aid.

# Step 2: Log into myBlackHawk

- Reference the welcome letter for myBlackHawk login instructions.
- Access myBlackHawk through the BHC website or myblackhawk.bhc.edu.

- Check your myBlackHawk email frequently for important messages.

### **Library Card**

- Get your Black Hawk College Library Card at the Quad-Cities Campus or East Campus libraries.
- Use your library card for free unlimited Metro Link rides.

#### **Books**

- Order books online.
- Pick up books at the Quad-Cities Campus in the Hawk's Hub in Building 1 or at the East Campus Bookstore in Building A.

# **Parking Permit**

- Purchase a permit for \$25 at the BHC Police Department at either campus, the Bursar's Office at the Quad-Cities Campus or Enrollment Services at the East Campus. Summers and minimesters are free.
- If you are using financial aid to buy your parking permit, pick up a voucher at the Hawk's Hub or the East Campus Bookstore.

### **Fall Classes**

Registration begins in April. Apply and start financial aid October-January.

#### **Summer Classes**

Registration begins in April.

Apply and start financial aid January-March.

Registration begins in November. Apply and start financial aid September-October.
