Determine if Placement Testing is Needed

Welcome to Black Hawk College! Before scheduling an advising appointment, it's essential to determine if placement testing is necessary.

***Note:** If you are pursuing any of the following programs, placement testing is not required, and you are ready to meet with advising staff: Equine Science, Horse Science Technology, Veterinary Assistant, Non-Transfer Agribusiness, Non-Transfer Agriculture Production, Automotive Technology, Agriculture Mechanics, Certified Nurse Assistant, and Welding.*

- **Recent High School Graduate (within the last 18 months):** Request your high school transcript, ACT scores from www.act.org, or SAT/AP scores from www.collegeboard.org.
- **Earned College Credits Elsewhere:** Request official transcripts.
- **No recent High School or College Attendance:** Schedule placement testing at www.bhc.edu/testingcenter.

STEP 2: Log in to your myBHC student portal. Reference email containing login information when you applied to BHC. Need help? Contact the Help Desk at 1-309-796-5555.

STEP 3: Email advqc@bhc.edu from your student email account or call 1-309-796-5100 to determine readiness for an advising appointment. **Please include your student ID number (900#####) in all email communications or have it ready when you call.**
