_____ Complete the TEAS test in the Testing Center, ILC (lower part of the Library) at the Quad-Cities by February 29, 2024. To be eligible, you will need a score equal to or greater than 50. To schedule an appointment for the test, please call 309-795-5170. TEAS test must be retaken if taken before December 1, 2022.

_____ Unofficial college transcripts:

- web-based transcripts are accepted
- current Black Hawk students can access transcripts at **myBlackHawk.bhc.edu**
- transcripts must show grades for each course, cumulative GPA, and currently enrolled courses
- If Black Hawk College's Enrollment Services has received your official transcripts from another school, please indicate that on the application. Transcripts do not need to be attached in this case. However, please verify with Enrollment Services that they have received your official transcript as your application will not be considered complete without them. (If courses appear on your MyBlackhawk transcript or Degree Audit with a "T" grade then they have been received by Enrollment Services).

_____ International Students:

- transcripts must be evaluated by WES or ECE

_____ A copy of your placement test results if needed (Compass, SAT, Accuplacer, ALEKS). If your test score is over 2 years and you have not taken a math course, we highly recommend you take ALEKS. Please contact Advising.

_____ TEAS Test (must be retaken if taken before December 1, 2022). Attach a copy of your scores if test has been completed.

_____ **TEAS testing.** I will complete the TEAS test in the Testing Center (ILC) by February 29, 2024. A score equal to or greater than 50 is required to be considered for admission. TEAS test must be retaken if taken before December 1, 2022.

_____ **HESI testing.** I am also applying to the Associate Degree Nursing program and I will complete the HESI test in the Testing Center (ILC) by February 29, 2024.

_____ My cumulative GPA at Black Hawk College is 2.0 or higher

_____ My cumulative GPA at Black Hawk College is below a 2.0 (see below, you must complete a plan with an advisor and include it with application if your cumulative GPA is below a 2.0)

Due to the required Black Hawk College GPA of 2.0 or better to graduate, you must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0 while in the LPN program. Upon application for admission to the LPN program, if your GPA is below 2.0 or if you have not yet earned a GPA, you must meet with a BHC academic advisor to create and sign an academic plan to attach to your application. The academic plan must reflect that your GPA can be maintained at or above 2.0 during the LPN program. If you are unable to graduate and receive your certificate from BHC you will not be allowed to sit for the post-program test (NCLEX). Successful completion of the NCLEX is required to receive Licensure to practice as a Licensed Practical Nurse. Call 309-796-5101 to schedule an appointment with an advisor to complete a plan.
