Courses listed below are BHC courses.

- Two Bachelor of Business (BB) degrees
 - Accounting – *Macomb campus and online*.
 - Business Administration with options in Business Analytics, Economics, Finance, Human Resources, Management, Marketing, and Supply Chain Management – *Macomb campus and most options also offered online (confirm with WIU)*
- One Bachelor of Arts will be offered in Economics -- *Macomb campus and online*
- To declare as a BB major, you must have a 2.5 GPA and 60 completed college-level credits including these courses with a grade of ‘C’ or better:
 - ACCT 101, 102, 103, & 104
 - ECON 221 & 222
 - MATH 112. WIU will substitute MATH 112 for its *MATH 123 Modeling with Mathematical Functions [IAI: M1 907]*.
 - MATH 108 or MATH 228
- Students are also recommended to take before transfer.; otherwise, they can be taken at WIU after transfer.
 - BUSN 110
 - CS 105 or CS 121 or CIP 104
 - PSYC 101 or SOC 101
 - Non-Accounting majors also take BL 201. Accounting majors will take an upper-division course after transfer.
- Courses no longer needed: BUSN 241 Intro to Supply Chain Management, CS 100 Intro to Computers, ECON 270 Global Business Today, and MATH 132 Calculus for Bus/Soc Sciences. If you have already taken any of these courses please discuss with WIU how they may be applied to your bachelor's degree.
