In order to be considered for admission to the Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA), all applicants following this guide are required to earn a cumulative 3.0 in major courses (no D grades are accepted in transfer) and apply by the posted deadline at colum.edu/bfa. Additionally, please note that the BFA is only available for fall admission and all applicants will be processed as Bachelor of Arts (BA) students if applying after the deadline. Students should work closely with their academic advisor to transition to the BFA. Contact transfer@colum.edu with any questions.

Students who complete the AFA would be waived from the following major requirements: ARTH 105 Introduction to Visual Culture, ARTS 103 Art Now! Speaker Series, and 3 credit hours of Foundation Skill.

Columbia College Chicago participates in the Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI). Students who complete the AFA degree at Black Hawk College as described within this guide will have completed the IAI General Education Core Curriculum (GECC) prior to transfer. Columbia College Chicago requires all degree-seeking Columbia students to complete 9 credit hours of 200-level (or higher) coursework, Columbia Experience courses as indicated, as well as at least 6 credit hours of courses with a Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) designation to meet graduation requirements.
