

The U.S. Senate Passes the TVPRA!

The Trafficking Victims Protection Reauthorization Act (TVPRA) was recently passed in the U.S. Senate as an amendment to the Violence Against Women Act (S. 47) with a vote of 93-5. Braking Traffik thanks all of you for contacting your Senators to advocate for the reauthorization of the TVPRA, which has assisted survivors and led to the prosecution of traffickers since first enacted in 2000.

We now encourage you to urge the U.S. House of Representatives to take up the Senate's bill to pass the TVPRA into law. Together we can ensure that survivors receive the care they need and that traffickers will be brought to justice.
