INSTRUCTIONAL FEE CHANGES FOR 2013-2014

REPORT:

AGRICULTURE

Rationale: The purpose of the new fee for the following Agriculture courses is to help cover the cost of the Dining Etiquette Training. It is a requirement of the courses and the collection of the fee using this process would simplify the process of administering it.

AG 100 Introduction to Agriculture: New fee of \$15

AG 101 Introductory Agriculture Seminar: New fee of \$15

BIOLOGY 251 Genetics Laboratory: New course (pending ICCB approval) New fee of \$25

Rationale: The purpose of the fee is to cover the costs associated with chemicals along with biological items.

COER 216 Advanced PC Hardware/A+ Preparation: New fee of \$175

Rationale: The purpose of this lab fee is to cover the cost of the industry certification examination for microcomputer hardware credentials (CompTIA and A+).

EQ 101 Introductory Equine Seminar: New fee of \$15

Rationale: The purpose of the fee is to help cover the cost of the Dining Etiquette Training. It is a requirement of the course and the collection of the fee using this process would simplify the process of administering it.

HEALTH INFORMATION MANAGEMENT

Rationale: The purpose of the fee for the following Health Information Management courses is to cover lab supplies for clinical medical assisting coursework.

HIM 147 Medical Assisting Clin Tech I: New fee of \$33

HIM 247 Medical Assisting Clin Tech II: New fee of \$33

NETW 185 CISCO IV: New fee of \$125

Rationale: The purpose of this lab fee is to cover the cost of an industry certification examination for the CISCO Certified Network Administrator credential (CISCOCCNA).

NETW 255 Advanced Networking/N+Prep: New fee of \$135

Rationale: The purpose of this lab fee is to cover the cost of the industry certification examination for networking credentials (CompTIA N+).

NETW 274 Ethical Hacking and Security: Increase fee from \$50 to \$185

Rationale: The purpose of increasing this lab fee is to cover the cost of an industry certification exam for networking credentials (CompTIA Security+).

PRACTICAL NURSING

Rationale: The purpose of increasing the lab fees for the following courses is to cover costs for the ATI Comprehensive Assessment and Review Program to improve student outcomes:

PN 111 Foundations of Practical Nursing: Fee Increase from \$50 to \$125

PN 112 Older Adult Nursing: Fee Increase from \$50 to \$125

PN 113 Adult Health Nursing: Fee Increase from \$50 to \$125

PN 114 Intergenerational Nursing: Fee Increase from \$50 to \$125

WELDING

The Welding Certificate Program has been revitalized in order to meet industry needs for trained welders. Recently, costs associated with the program have increased dramatically.

Rationale: The purpose of increasing the lab fees for the following courses is to more accurately cover the cost of expendable materials associated with course delivery:

WLD 101 Intro to Arc Welding: Fee increase from \$40 to \$60

WLD 102 Basic Arc Welding in the Flat Position: Fee increase from \$40 to \$60

WLD 103 Arc Welding in the Flat & Horizontal Positions: Fee increase from \$70 to \$95

WLD 105 Oxy-acetylene Welding & Cutting: Fee increase from \$70 to \$95

WLD 117 Arc Welding in the Vertical Position: Fee increase from \$70 to \$95

WLD 118 Arc Welding in the Overhead Position: Fee increase from \$70 to \$95

WLD 120 Introduction to MIG Welding: Fee increase from \$70 to \$95

WLD 121 MIG Welding with Spray Arc Process: Fee increase from \$70 to \$95

WLD 122 MIG Welding with Globular Transfer & Short Arc: Fee increase from \$70 to \$95

WLD 125 TIG Welding: Fee increase from \$70 to \$95

WLD 151 Shielded Metal Arc Welding I: Fee Increase from \$110 to \$140

WLD 152 Shielded Metal Arc Welding II: Fee increase from \$210 to \$240

WLD 199 Welding Competency Transitions: Fee increase from \$110 to \$140

WLD 251 Introduction to MIG Welding: Fee Increase from \$140 to \$180

WLD 252 Introduction to TIG Welding: Fee increase from \$140 to \$180
