Advisors would be glad to assist you with your academic advising needs; but first, we want to make sure you are ready to meet with one of our team members. Please complete the **3 easy steps** outlined below. Advisors utilize multiple measures to assess your Reading, Writing and Math skills.

#### Are you a recent high school graduate (within the last 18 months):

If you have graduated from high school within the last 18 months, please contact your high school to have your official transcript sent to <a href="Registrar@bhc.edu">Registrar@bhc.edu</a> or by mail. Your advisor may use high school coursework to determine college-readiness.

Additionally, advisors utilize your ACT or SAT scores for placement. Please send your ACT/SAT scores. To request a score report, go to the ACT web page at <a href="www.act.org">www.act.org</a> or to the SAT web page at <a href="www.sat.org">www.sat.org</a> to have your official score report sent to <a href="Registrar@bhc.edu">Registrar@bhc.edu</a> or by mail.

#### **Have you earned college credits at another community college or university:**

Contact your transfer institution(s) to request an official transcript be sent to Enrollment Services. Once you verify your transcript(s) have been sent, please send an e-mail from your myBlackhawk account to <a href="Registrar@bhc.edu">Registrar@bhc.edu</a> and request that Enrollment Services evaluate your transfer coursework and apply those courses to your BHC transcript.

## You have not attended another college/university and it has been over 18 months since graduating high school:

You will need to complete the Accuplacer test. To prepare for the test, visit: www.accuplacer.org.

### **Additional Important Notes**:

- Students who are going to major in the following career programs do <u>NOT</u> have to have ACT or SAT scores, nor do they have to complete the Accuplacer to schedule an appointment with an Advisor: Equine Science, Horse Science Technology, Veterinary Assistant, Non-Transfer Agribusiness, Non-Transfer Agriculture Production, Automotive Technology, Agriculture Mechanics, Certified Nurse Assistant and Welding.
- If you have any advanced placement scores, please visit <a href="www.collegeboard.org">www.collegeboard.org</a> and send scores to <a href="Registrar@bhc.edu">Registrar@bhc.edu</a> or by mail.
- If courses were taken while in high school through the BHC Dual Enrollment program, advisors will see those courses on your BHC transcript.

**STEP 2**: Login to your myBlackHawk account. When you filled out the application for admissions, you received a welcome email as well as an email outlining your myBlackHawk login information. Click here if you need help accessing myBlackhawk.

#### Additional recommended steps:
