Students who complete the ACT+Writing after September 10, 2016, need to earn a 22 composite and a 6 on the English/Writing section. Students who complete the SAT after March 5, 2016, need to earn a 1110 composite score (Reading, Writing, Math) and a 26 on the Writing &amp; Language section.</b> <b>A grade of 'C' or better is required for all directed general education courses, all core courses, and all courses in the major.</b>

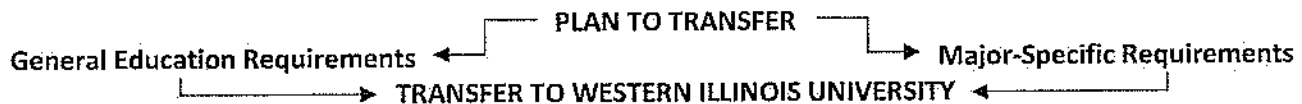

### Start Your Transfer Experience

This transfer guide will help you plan courses at Black Hawk College that will meet general education and major-specific requirements at Western Illinois University. Work closely with your Black Hawk College advisor and your WIU Admissions Representative when planning and selecting your coursework. Preparing well will ensure that you save time and money by taking courses that are required for your major.



### Plan Your Community College Classes

Follow the steps below to plan your community college courses to match general education requirements at Western Illinois University. General education courses are a required part of your bachelor's degree.

#### Western Illinois University General Education Requirements

- 9 hours of English Composition & Public Speaking
- 10 hours of Mathematics & Natural Science
- 9 hours of Social Sciences
- 9 hours of Humanities/Fine Arts
- 3 hours of Multicultural Studies
- 3 hours of Human Well-Being

#### Which Associate Degree Should I Choose?

**AA**

**Associate of Art** – Completion of this degree will satisfy WIU General Education requirements. This degree is designed to transfer and parallel the first two years of a bachelor's degree.

**AS**

**Associate of Science** – Completion of this degree will satisfy some WIU General Education requirements but does not guarantee all requirements will be met. This degree is designed to transfer into math & science-related majors.

**AAS**

**Associate of Applied Science** – Completion of this degree will not meet WIU General Education requirements. This degree is designed for direct employment, and is not designed to transfer.
