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

## Agriculture

### Creepy Crawlers

Do a deep dive into learning about both internal and external parasites by discussing how animals can get parasites. You will spend time in the laboratory looking into microscopes to discover what these creepy crawlers really look like.



### Figuring the Feed

**Instructor: Sarah Schobert**

Do you love a good brainteaser? Are you crazy for anything with four legs and a tail? If you answered yes to both of these questions, you may be an animal nutritionist in the making! Come learn the basics of what goes into making feed for a cow and other species!



### Flower Power

**Instructor: Taylor Wilkinson**

Do you enjoy art and science? Look no further! In Flower Power, you will use your creativity and your love of science. Floral design uses your art skills, flowers and your imagination! You will create magical and beautiful designs out of flowers you can find in your own backyard and in nature! Learn which flowers attract pollinators and ones you can grow from year to year very easily. This class will get you in an artistic mood, and you will learn to design arrangements you can make for years to come.



### Horsin' Around

What is an exotic pet? In this course we will cover more common nontraditional pets, as well as the basic requirements of those animals to maintain their health. These animals depend on their owners for survival, and you'll learn the basics in husbandry to keep your pet healthy.



## Raising Orphaned Animals

**Instructor: Dr. Colleen Lewis**

Do you have what it takes to be an animal rehabilitator? This session is about rescuing and caring for orphaned animals living in the wild and on the farm. It is vitally important to know when to help an apparently orphaned animal and when to leave it alone. Learn which animals you can help and how to support them with food, hydration and regulation of their body temperature in an emergency. Learn how to get the help an animal needs and make a long-term plan for your future as an animal caregiver! **Students will be required to wear long pants and closed-toe shoes for this course.**



## Ready, Set, Grow!

**Instructor: Taylor Wilkinson**

What does it take to start a garden? Have you ever wanted to learn how? This class can teach you! We will discover what types of gardens exist, how to plan a garden, what seeds and plants to buy and when to plant them, and when to harvest and pick your goodies. For three days, you will have the ability to design, create and explore the opportunities of gardening. We will also travel to the Black Hawk College greenhouse and learn why they're important. **It's gonna get dirty, so dress accordingly!**

## Technology

### Drones

**Instructor: Jodee Werkheiser**

Drones, drones, everywhere! Learn about the different types of drones, drone safety and industries utilizing this newer technology. You might even get to fly a drone!

## Trades

### Welding

**Instructor: Patrick Ericson**

Interested in being a welder or learning more about welding in general? Spark your interest with this class! You'll learn about welding safety, the different processes of welding (GMAW, SMAW, GTAW) as well as different uses for welding. Not only will you learn, but you'll get the opportunity to run some beads in the welding lab! See welding in artwork, race cars, yard ornaments, farm repairs and more! Welding is all around us, let the fun begin!

**For this course, students will need to wear closed-toe shoes (leather boots are preferred) and long pants (blue jeans), nonflammable shirts or jackets. Do not wear dry fit or polyester as these materials will melt to the body if they burn. Avoid pant cuffs or rolling up sleeves as sparks or hot metal will deposit in the folds and may burn through the material.**

**This class will be at the Black Hawk College Welding and Skilled Trades Center in Kewanee. Students will be transported by Black Hawk College staff to and from classes. All students need to report to the East Campus each morning.**



## Health/Science

### The Bees' Knees!

**Instructor: Isaac Stewart**

Do all bees make honey? Do all bees leave their stingers behind? How do bees live their lives? Did you know there are more than 20,000 types of bees on Earth? We will explore the diversity of bees, observe bees in the laboratory and the field, and begin to appreciate the group of organisms officially declared to be "the most important living being on Earth."

## Comparative Anatomy Within the Animal Kingdom

**Instructor: Katie Rushing-Anderson**

Learn about characteristics that make animals unique, observe similarities and differences between organisms within the animal kingdom, and learn to dissect specimens from animal phyla, including: Mollusca, Arthropoda, Echinodermata and Chordata.



## Chemistry, Physics, Escape

**Instructor: Dr. Alan Abbott**

First, channel your inner chemist and find number clues using acids, bases, phase changes and oxidations. Then, flex your physics muscles to find clues using fluorescence, polarization, refraction and magnification. Finally, put your brain to the test and use your talents to escape the lab!

## First Aid + CPR

**Instructor: Katy Loibl**

Imagine this: you are walking down the hall of your school and you see a classmate lean against the wall then slump to the floor. You're worried, so you check on her. Wouldn't you love to know what to do to help your classmate? Join our CPR and first aid class and you'll know what to do in an emergency!



## Making an Insect Collection

Insect collecting has exploded as a hobby since the Italian Renaissance, but did you know that scientists rely on insect collections as a source of historical data? This course will teach you how to collect, preserve and identify the most diverse group of creatures that Earth has to offer. Going outside to collect in the field will be required, and bringing specimens already collected is encouraged! Successful students will leave the course with a collection suitable for 4-H.

### Medieval Times


## Discipline Issues
