

How to Find an Article—Databases by Subject

- On your Canvas course page, click **Library**—this will take you to the Library homepage
- Or go to <https://www.bhc.edu/academics/academic-resources/library/>
- Click on the **Databases by Subject** button, this will take you to the **Databases by Subject** page
- Click on a **subject heading** in the menu across the top. **General Resources** is a good place to start
- Click on an **article database** in that subject heading. **Academic Search Ultimate** is a general database that covers a wide variety of subjects and has many full-text articles
- Use your **myBlackHawk username and password when asked to login**
- ****Type** a few good search terms in the query box and click **Search**—you may type more than one word, but do not use complete sentences.
- **Limit results:** there are several ways to limit your results,
 - **Check Full Text** **Limit date of publication**
 - **Choose Source type** **Choose Peer Reviewed**
- **Review** the result's list for an interesting article
- **Click** the article title and read the abstract to determine if the article will be useful
- **View** the article by clicking the **HTML** or **PDF** icon
- **Print** or **Save** the article or **Email** it to yourself
- **Find and save the Citation**
- **Click on Citing Sources** for instructions on how to create **Hanging Indentations**
- **To search a different database, go back to a subject heading and click on another title link**

- Click **Library** on your Canvas course page—this will take you to the Library homepage

- Click on the **Databases A-Z** button, this will take you to the **Databases A-Z** page
- Click on the **first letter of the database name**
- Click on the **database name**
- Use your **myBlackHawk username and password when asked to login**
