We now have an institutional license for LinkedIn Learning. This resource is available **for BHC students, faculty, and staff.**

LinkedIn Learning, formerly Lynda.com, is an **online educational platform** that helps you discover and develop business, technology-related, and creative skills through expert-led course videos. It has more than 16,000 courses taught by industry-experts. You can discover, complete, and track courses related to your field and areas of interest. You can add these courses and related skills to your LinkedIn profile once you have completed them.

For faculty, LinkedIn Learning **content can be added to your Canvas course page** by embedding or linking to content.

Start using LinkedIn Learning:

1. Go to <http://www.linkedin.com/learning/activate>.
2. Enter your @bhc.edu or @mymail.bhc.edu email address.
3. Click **Verify email**.
4. When you receive your activation email, click **Get started**.
5. Upon activation, you can connect to your LinkedIn profile OR you can create a separate Learning account during activation.
