I want to thank you for your commitment to your peers and instructors at BHC as we continue to evolve with our COVID-19 procedures.

Governor Pritzker has renewed the Executive Order requiring students to be vaccinated or test once per week at the SHIELD Illinois testing sites, located on each campus. Failure to either be vaccinated or test weekly may result in discipline.
