## General Education Core Curriculum completion post-matriculation

Under the following circumstances, institutions will offer transfer students the option of satisfying lowerdivision general education requirements by completing a GECC curriculum while enrolled in the receiving institution.

- When the transfer student has completed a statewide articulated associate degree such as the AFA, AES, AAT; or
- When the transfer student has been granted 30 semester hours of transfer credit by the receiving
  institution without having completed the GECC. (Although not specified, the nature of lowerdivision curricula indicates that 30 semester hours of transfer credit from an IAI institution will
  likely incorporate GECC credits.)
