### Psychology

The 2+2 is a four-year plan that leads to a Bachelor of Science degree in Psychology at Western Illinois University (WIU).

Students intending to complete a Bachelor of Science (B.S.) degree in Psychology from WIU should follow the Associate in Arts (A.A.) degree program outlined in this handout from Black Hawk College (BHC).

Students who complete the A.A. degree at Black Hawk College may transfer to WIU and complete their B.S. degree in Psychology in an additional two years.

3. Social Science elective needs to be from a discipline other than Psychology.
4. The AA degree requires completion of one Non-Western studies course within general education requirements (humanities, fine arts or social science).
