Transfer Planning Guide



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TRANSFER FACTS

- Students applying to the [Elementary Education major](#) at Augustana College must have a minimum grade point average of 3.0 to be considered for admission. After transfer, a GPA of 3.0 must be maintained and will be computed only on courses taken at Augustana. Early contact with the [Augustana Education Department](#) is encouraged.
- Students who use this guide in conjunction with the Black Hawk College Associate in Arts (AA), may transfer to Augustana and complete the BA in Elementary Education, earning the recommendation for licensure in grades 1-6, in an additional two years plus a semester of student teaching.
- Students who earn the AA at Black Hawk will meet the Learning Perspective requirement at Augustana.
- In addition to Learning Perspective requirements, students must meet the Writing, Second Language, Reasoned Examination of Faith (REF), Physical Education activities, Transfer Transitions course (LSC 300) and the Suffix requirements: Quantitative (Q), Global Diversity (G), Multicultural Diversity (D).
- Second Language, and Physical Education can be included in the Associate in Arts degree and will advance degree progress at Augustana. *Suffix requirements will be met within the Education curriculum at Augustana.*
- Prior to transferring, students should have completed the second language requirement (Spanish is recommended).
- [Basic Skills testing](#). The Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP) is not currently offered; however, ACT and SAT score requirements are found at [Basic Skills testing](#). Students who did not earn the minimum scores while in High School, should retake the ACT or SAT in their sophomore year.

NOTES:

- Augustana College has a second language requirement for graduation that students may meet in one of the following ways:
 - Completion of four years of a single second language in high school.
 - Satisfactory performance on a competency test at Augustana.
 - Completion of course 102 in a second language at Augustana.
 - The equivalent of one year of a second language at another college (101 & 102 at Black Hawk College).
 - MATH 108 meets both the Quantitative (Q) requirement as well as BHC’s Math requirement.
 - Augustana’s Education department recommends but does not require that this course be taken at Augustana.
 - Students may select two one-hour Physical Education Activity courses from the PE category. May also be completed at Augustana.
 - Reasoned Examination of Faith (REF) is a required course to take at Augustana.
 - LSC 300, Transfer Transitions, is a graduation requirement for all transfer students. Take in the first semester after transfer.
 - If MATH 210 taken at BHC, student may choose another elective course.
- ** Early transfer may be appropriate for students who completed four years of a single second language in high school. Students transferring to Augustana prior to completing the AA degree should complete the indicated courses before transfer.

Augustana Suggested Course Sequence

Note: This course sequence assumes the AA has been completed prior to transfer and that the student begins in the fall semester at Augustana. The 5th Year, Fall Semester will be dedicated to student teaching.
