

## Black Hawk College /Augustana College: Elementary Education Articulation

Students applying to the [Elementary Education major](#) must have a minimum grade point average of 3.0. to be considered for admission. After transfer, a GPA of 3.0 must be maintained and will be computed only on courses taken at Augustana. **Early contact with the Augustana Education Department is encouraged.**

### Option 1: Complete the Associate in Arts degree prior to transfer

The courses listed below are designed to complete the [Associate in Arts \(AA\) Degree](#) at Black Hawk College prior to transferring to Augustana. The AA requires 64 credits to graduate. Prior to transferring, students must complete the foreign language requirement and have met the State of Illinois basic skills requirement via the ACT, SAT, or TAP. After transfer, students will require two years and one term to complete a major in Elementary Education and earn the recommendation for licensure as an Elementary Teacher in grades 1 - 6. *Note: if a student wishes to transfer to Augustana before completing the AA degree, please refer to Option 2 of this guide.*

Communications (9 credits; 3 courses)

- ENG 101 - Composition 1
  - ENG 102 - Composition 2
  - SPEC 101 - Principles of Speech Communication
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Humanities and Fine Arts (9 credits; 3 courses; at least 1 Humanities, 1 Fine Arts. **Note:** students will take one additional art class at Augie)

- ENG 240 - Children's Literature **Note:** Children's Lit at Augie is a 300-level course integrated into the Literacy Methods sequence. Augie will accept ENG 240 in lieu of its ENGL-314, but suggests taking the course at Augie. If taken at Augie, choose a different humanities course to satisfy BHC's graduation requirement.
  - MUSC 154 – Music Appreciation **or** MUSC 256 - Introduction to American Music **or** MUSC 158 Introduction to Non-Western Music. (**MUSC 158 also satisfies BHC's non-western course requirement**)
  - Choice: \_\_\_\_\_ Consider SPAN 202 if 4 years of one foreign language in high school was not completed.
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Social and Behavioral Sciences (9 credits; 3 courses)

- PSYC 101 - Intro to Psychology
  - ECON 221 - Macro Economics **or** ECON 222 - Micro Economics
  - GEOG 105 - Introductory Regional Geography (**also satisfies BHC's non-western course requirement**). **Note:** If GEOG 105 is not available at BHC, an equivalent course may be completed at Augie after transfer to meet state licensing requirement.)
- *Take the following toward elective credits:*
- HIST 105 - US History to 1877 **or** HIST 106 - US History Since 1877
  - POLS 122 - American National Government
  - PSYC 262 - Child Psychology
  - SOC 101 - Principles of Sociology **or** SOC 250 - Minority Relations
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Mathematics (3 credits; 1 course)

- MATH 108 - Statistics for General Education
- *Take the following toward elective credits:*
- MATH 112 - College Algebra
  - MATH 210 – Math for Teaching and Learning
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Physical and Life Sciences (7 credits; 2 courses, at least course must include a lab)

**Note:** students will take one additional lab science course at Augie.

- BIOL 100 - Introduction to Biology (lab course) **or** BIOL 105 - General Biology I (lab course)
  - PHYS 101 College Physics I (lab course) **or** PHYS 140 Practical Physics
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Foreign Language requirement for Augie: If students have **not** completed four years of one high school foreign language (Spanish is suggested), then electives should be used to complete the equivalent of 1 year of college level foreign language at Black Hawk:

- \_\_\_ SPAN 101 **and** SPAN 102 **-OR-**
- \_\_\_ SPAN 102 **or** SPAN 103 **or** SPAN 201 **or** SPAN 202 **or** SPAN 253 **or** SPAN 254

**For remaining elective credits**, take 1 or 2 Physical Education activity courses (PE 101 through PE 191)

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## **Option 2: Transfer to Augustana prior to completing the AA degree**

Note: Fourteen courses are listed below. If you must take two courses to fulfill the foreign language requirement, then omit the courses in SECTION THREE below.

Foreign Language requirement for Augie: If students have not completed four years of one high school foreign language (Spanish is suggested), then electives should be used to complete the equivalent of 1 year of college level foreign language at Black Hawk:

- \_\_\_ SPAN 101 and SPAN 102
  - OR
  - \_\_\_ SPAN 102 **or** SPAN 103 **or** SPAN 201 **or** SPAN 202 **or** SPAN 253 **or** SPAN 254
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SECTION ONE. Complete the following courses:

- \_\_\_ ENG 101 - Composition 1
  - \_\_\_ ENG 102 - Composition 2
  - \_\_\_ SPEC 101 - Principles of Speech Communication
  - \_\_\_ PSYC 101 - Intro to Psychology
  - \_\_\_ ECON 221 - Macro Economics **or** ECON 222 - Micro Economics
  - \_\_\_ MATH 112 – College Algebra
  - \_\_\_ MATH 108 - Statistics for General Education
  - \_\_\_ BIOL 100 - Introduction to Biology (lab course) **or** BIOL 105 - General Biology I (lab course)
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SECTION TWO. If you have time after completing the foreign language requirement, then complete:

- \_\_\_ PHYS 101 College Physics I (lab course) **or** PHYS 140 Practical Physics
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SECTION THREE. If you still have time after completing the foreign language requirement, select from:

- \_\_\_ PSYC 262 - Child Psychology
  - \_\_\_ HIST 105 - US History to 1877 **or** HIST 106 - US History Since 1877
  - \_\_\_ POLS 122 - American National Government
  - \_\_\_ MUSC 154 – Music Appreciation **or** MUSC 256 - Introduction to American Music **or** MUSC 158 Introduction to Non-Western Music.
  - \_\_\_ Physical Education activity courses (PE 101 through PE 191)
