TRANSFER FACTS

- The courses listed on this guide indicate the recommended programs of study for Black Hawk College students wishing to complete a Bachelor’s degree in Business at Bradley University. These outlines ensure that students can obtain an [Associate in Arts](#) degree while preparing to complete a Bachelor’s degree within four years.
- An application for admission to Bradley University should be submitted at the beginning of the sophomore year. The [Foster College of Business](#) will review all applications.
- A minimum GPA of 2.0 is required and completion of the general education math course is strongly recommended prior to transfer. Students will receive an evaluation of all course-work at the time of admission. Students should consult Bradley in planning remaining courses at BHC.
- New transfer students may register for fall semester courses during (not after) April and for spring semester courses during (not after) October.
- The Business Core is required of all Foster College of Business graduates and may be started at Black Hawk College prior to transfer. For the complete Business Core, and the full range of Business Majors, concentrations and minors see <https://www.bradley.edu/academic/colleges/fcba/programs/>
- Foster College of Business 300-400 level business core courses or courses required in a business major taken on 100-200 level at another institution will not transfer into the Foster College of Business.
- Foster College of Business does not accept business courses in transfer with a grade of “D”
- CLEP general mathematics credit will not be accepted in lieu of the required mathematics courses nor does the College grant any credit toward graduation for CLEP in mathematics.
- All programs offered by the Foster College of Business are accredited by the [AACSB International](#): The Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business.
