



Transfer Planning Guide for St. Ambrose University General Education Requirements

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This guide is intended for students who plan to transfer to St. Ambrose University (SAU) prior to earning the Associate in Arts (AA) or the Associate in Science (AS) degree.

- Students transferring prior to degree completion are encouraged to select courses at Black Hawk College based on SAU's general education requirements and the requirements for their chosen SAU major.
- A maximum of 64 community college credits will be applied toward the minimum of 120 credits required for SAU graduation. Some of SAU's general education requirements may be completed after transfer.
- Credit for college level work is granted in all areas that correspond to courses offered at SAU with a grade of "C" or better.
- CLEP and Advanced Placement credit are subject to review at SAU on an individual basis. Send scores from these exams to SAU.
- **Dual Admission:** Interested students should complete an SAU Application for Dual Admission and submit required transcripts. Dual admission students will have access to transfer advising and planning, early transfer admission orientation programs, and other SAU resources, activities and facilities. Students admitted to the dual admission program prior to completing 30 credit hours will receive a scholarship of \$1,000 beyond other SAU academic and institutional scholarships.
- **Guaranteed Admission:** Students are required to participate in the program between their first semester of enrollment at BHC and prior to, or upon completion, of the first 30 semester credits hours at BHC. Students must transfer to SAU within three years of the initial enrollment at BHC and maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 on all course work from all colleges attended. A transferrable GPA of 3.5 will also guarantee an invitation to apply to SAU's Honors Program. Acceptance in some SAU degree programs is competitive and through a separate application and acceptance process.
