

Transfer Planning Guide

TRANSFER FACTS

- Students transferring to Augustana as Psychology majors who use this guide in conjunction with the Black Hawk College Associate in Arts (AA), may transfer to Augustana and complete their BA in Psychology **in an additional two years**.
- Students who earn the AA at Black Hawk will meet the Learning Perspective requirement at Augustana.
- In addition to Learning Perspective requirements, students must meet the Writing, Second Language, Reasoned Examination of Faith (REF), Physical Education activities, Transfer Transitions course (LSC 300) and the Suffix requirements, Quantitative (Q), Global Diversity (G), Multicultural Diversity (D).
- Learning Perspectives, Second Language, Physical Education and Suffix requirements can be included in the Associate in Arts degree to be able to complete the BA at Augustana in two years.
- Students must earn a minimum of 60 semester hours at Augustana to graduate.

NOTES:

1. Augustana College has a second language requirement for graduation that students may meet in one of the following ways: • Completion of four years of a single second language in high school. • Satisfactory performance on a competency test at Augustana. • Completion of course 102 in a foreign language at Augustana. • The equivalent of one year of a foreign language at another college (101 & 102 at Black Hawk College).
2. Math 108 is recommended as it will meet both the Quantitative (Q) requirement as well as substitute for Augustana’s PSYC 240, Psychology Statistics.
3. Electives may include courses toward a second major or minor at Augustana. Refer to Augustana website at www.augustana.edu for other possible major/minors. Electives may also include ENG 100 and/or REA 103 if required by BHC assessment. See also note #5.
4. Recommended elective within Psychology.
5. All Augustana students must complete a course in both the Global Diversity (G) and Multicultural Diversity (D) suffixes. **One course may meet multiple requirements, so** BHC students may use the table below to see courses that satisfy these various requirements.
