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## Agricultural Science

- The 2+2 is a four-year plan that leads to a Bachelor of Science (B.S.) degree in Agriculture at WIU. Students will fill out applications for both schools, and consult the advisors and the catalogs for both schools for specifics. This completion guide is designed to ensure graduation in four years by taking courses at both BHC and WIU. This guide assumes students have met all course prerequisites required by BHC and admission requirements for WIU.
- Upon completion of the first two years' requirements at BHC, students will receive an Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree. Students will be required to complete the Agricultural core requirements at WIU, and upon completion of the final two years' curriculum requirements students will receive the B.S. degree with a major in Agricultural Science at WIU. In general, a minimum of 64 semester hours (s.h.) will be taken at BHC at BHC rates and 60 s.h. from WIU at WIU rates.
- A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00 should be achieved by the junior year. These grade point averages must be maintained for graduation as an Agricultural Science major.

**Notes for BHC:**

1. Minimum of 20 hours of agriculture elective hours are required. To meet both BHC and WIU requirements, the 4 following AG Electives must be completed in a student's field of study: 1) AG 282(4 hrs.); 2) AG 283(4 hrs.) or HORT 284 (3 hrs.); 3) AG 285 (4 hrs.); and 4) AG 287(4 hrs). Consult with your Academic Advisor; WIU AGRI 120 requirement will be waived with a BHC 3 hr. AG Elective;
2. See advisor for guidance in selection of Life Science and Physical Science options - must have one course in BIOL and one course in CHEM; at least one lab science class is required for BHC graduation (4 s.h.);
3. An overall grade point average of 2.0 and a "C" grade or better is required in ENG 101 and ENG 102 (English Composition I & II);
4. Additional math prerequisites may be required based on the student's math placement scores. Students would be required to complete these prerequisite classes with a grade of C or higher. Courses below college level will not apply toward graduation;
5. BHC has a Non-Western studies requirement which may be met by taking a Non-Western course in social science, fine arts or humanities (Ex. ENG 217, 218, 219; ART 285, 286; MUSC 158; ANTH 102, GEOG 105, HIST 141, 142, 151, 222; IS 220; or POLS 262);
6. Students should consult the Black Hawk College catalog for a listing of IAI courses which meet degree requirements;

**Notes for WIU:**
