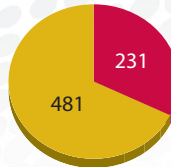

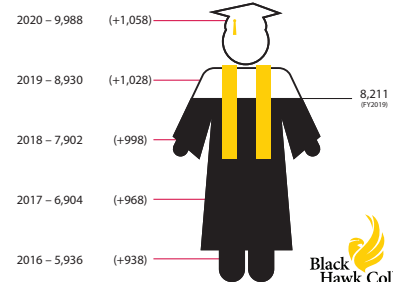
Black Hawk College enriches the community by providing the environment and educational resources for individuals to become lifelong learners.
